



Call for 2010/11 Scientific Exchange Applications

The Cotton Catchment Communities CRC Ltd (Cotton CRC) is seeking applications for Scientific Exchanges for 2010/11. A limited number of projects, with a maximum budget of \$5,000 each, may be funded. Costs of travel, accommodation and ancillary expenses such as conference registrations may be supported, but stipends or salaries will not.

Scientific Exchanges are intended primarily to foster the Cotton CRC's international linkages, and may be used to support overseas visits by staff that are salaried and in-kind to the Cotton CRC, or visits by overseas colleagues to institutions which are participants in the Cotton CRC. Applications for travel within Australia may also be considered. We are particularly interested in applications to bring overseas staff to Australia.
